HCA ADMISSIONS POLICY:

- The parents and/or the High School student must be born-again, Bible-believing, Christ-honoring Christians. (An exception may be made when only one parent is a born-again believer provided the non-believing spouse agrees not to oppose the Biblical teaching of the Academy). The parents must declare in writing that they have accepted and continue to acknowledge, Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior (Student Application).
- Parents must state in writing that they agree with the school's Doctrinal Statement, and both parents must agree to have their children educated in accord with it (Student Application).
- Parents must have read, agreed with, and signed the Statement of Parent or Guardian (Student Application).
- Parents and applicant (grades 6-12) will be interviewed separately by the Director of Admissions.
- All prospective kindergarten students must be five years old by October 1st of the school year that he/she is to start kindergarten.
- All prospective kindergarten students will be given a readiness test.
- All prospective students (grades 1-12) will be tested as follows:
 - Students entering grades 1-5 will be given the BASIS Test (Basic Achievement Skills Individual Screener) and the Otis-Lennon School Ability Test.
 - Students entering grades 6-8 will be given the the Otis-Lennon School Ability Test.
 - Students entering 9-12 will be given the Otis-Lennon School Ability Test and a Mathematics Placement test, based on the math level they have most recently completed.
- Students will be considered for admission if their achievement test scores fall into the fourth or higher stanine for Lower and Middle School students and the fifth or higher stanine for High School students. All students in grades 1-12 should have a school ability index of 95 or higher on the Otis-Lennon Test.
- Students will not be considered for admission to the twelfth grade unless the transfer is due to a major geographic move.
- In most cases decisions regarding admission of students to HCA will be based on the date the application is received by the Admissions Office along with all materials submitted, including the application fee. Siblings of current HCA students have priority over prospective students in the wait pool.
- The Admissions Committee will determine the admissibility of a student based upon the information forwarded to the Committee and the interviews.
- The Admissions Committee may deny admittance to a student with severe academic, disciplinary, or psychological needs as HCA does not, at this time, have the resources to adequately provide proper education regarding these specialized needs. Any nondisclosure of pertinent information pertaining to these stated areas may result in forfeiture of enrollment.

- Acceptance or rejection of applicants will be by written notification. All decisions of the Admissions Committee are final.
- The school does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origins in the administration of its admissions policies.
- Students in grades 6-12 who anticipate competing on an interscholastic athletic team must file with the Academy a Sports Physical Form completed after July 1 of the current year along with other documents. These forms can be obtained HERE.
